

The New Bristol Mountain Freestyle Team

If you have been skiing or riding at Bristol Mountain, you may have seen the Freestyle Team in the moguls or practicing aeriels. Quality coaching has elevated the Bristol Mountain Freestyle Team into one of the premiere teams in the east. This season, the program has been expanded to include terrain park and halfpipe training for snowboarders, and skiers, with coaching at local USASA events. Our goal is to provide these new disciplines with quality coaching, while continuing to emphasis a safe and fun learning environment.

The Bristol Mountain Freestyle Team provides athletes with the opportunity to master their freestyle skiing/riding skills in competitive moguls, big air, terrain park and the halfpipe. Whether you are interested in training hard with the hope of making the US Freestyle Team someday, compete at local event, or you just want to improve your mogul, air, or pipe skills, we have a program that can fit your needs. The Bristol Mountain freestyle coaching staff brings many years of experience in both coaching and competing to the program.

The Freestyle Team is for those individuals interested in taking their freestyle skiing/riding to the next level. Training will consist of personal skiing/riding and skills development, mogul skiing skills/tactics, big air, terrain park and halfpipe tactics skills, and maneuvers. A strong emphasis is placed on safe skiing/riding and having fun. The team will train Saturdays and Sundays December 9, 2006 through March 11, 2007. There is no class December 24th. Coaching is from 10 am to 3 pm. Registration includes season long coaching and coaching at USSA/USASA sanctioned events.

FREESTYLE PROGRAM REGULATIONS

1. Freestyle programs are available for children age 8 through adult, from intermediate to advanced. These programs are designed to take your skiing or snowboarding skills to a new level, while making new friends, and participating in a series of fun activities extended to program participants.
2. Advance registration is recommended prior to January 1st due to limited class sizes. Program rates increase \$20 per participant starting January 1, 2007.
3. Classes are determined by age and skill level. Class sizes range from 8 to 10 students. Requests for placement with friends or a specific coach are accommodated to the best of our ability on the first day of the program. The group remains with the same coach throughout the duration of the program.
4. Purchasers of the regular-rate Mogulrunners or Parkrunners programs will receive a season pass valid on Saturdays from December 23rd through March 10th from 8 am to 5 pm. Purchasers of the regular-rate Mogulmasters program will receive a season pass valid on Sundays from January 7th through March 11th from 8 am to 5 pm. Season passes are issued in the Guest Services Office during regular business hours. Season passes are nontransferable. Replacement cost for lost passes is \$15. Members of the Freestyle Competition Team must purchase a season pass separately.
5. Participants may purchase a ten-time or twelve-time meal card. The meal card includes a choice of: (1) taco, hamburger, hotdog, pizza, or PB&J sandwich, (2) french fries or soup, (3) milk, hot chocolate, or soda, and (4) a cookie. Meal cards are mailed prior to the first day of class and are nonrefundable. Lost cards may be replaced at the regular retail rate.
6. **The enclosed Bristol Mountain Assumption of All Risks and Indemnification Agreement as well as the Parental Agreement and Indemnification (if participant is under the age of 18) must be signed by the participant and/or parent prior to the first day of class. Participant will not be able to participate in Brigade without the completed form on file at Bristol Mountain.**
7. On the program's first day, participants must check in at the Information/Ski School Desk in the Main Lodge between 8 am and 9:30 am.
8. Classes are held rain or shine. If severe weather prevents classes from being held, an announcement will be made on the snow report at 585-234-5000 along with rescheduled dates.
9. A make-up ski or snowboard day is extended to participants. The make-up day does not include a lesson and is scheduled the week after completion of each program as follows: Mogulrunners and Parkrunners-Saturday, March 17th; Mogulmasters-Sunday, March 18th. There is no make-up day for the Freestyle Team.

FREESTYLE PROGRAMS

Mogulrunners, Ages 8-18

Similar to the Forerunners Race Program, Mogul Runners (part of our Freestyle team) is designed to introduce intermediate and advanced skiers to freestyle skiing. It is not designed for those wishing to compete on a regular basis, but if participants develop an interest in competing in local events, the Freestyle Team coaching staff will provide coaching at those events.

Parkrunners, Ages 8-18

This program introduces intermediate and advanced skiers/snowboarders to the terrain parks. Basic skills of riding the pipe, rails, and big air hits are developed. Safe use and etiquette within the park will be stressed. Participants will be instructed in flat terrain and mogul skiing/riding.

Mogulmasters, Ages 19+

Whether you are interested in dominating at "Bump This" or desire the ability to link comfortable turns in the bumps, this is your program. Coaches will demonstrate proper technique and show you how easy it is to master the moguls! For the real adventurous souls, we will spend time working on jumping, but if you would rather keep your feet on the ground, that's cool.
